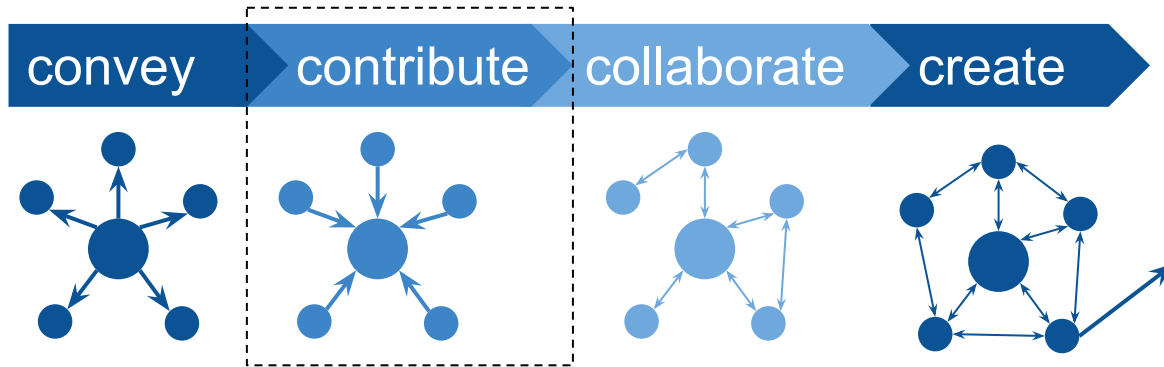

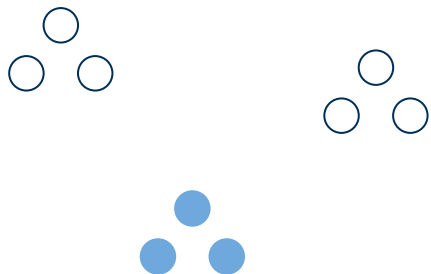

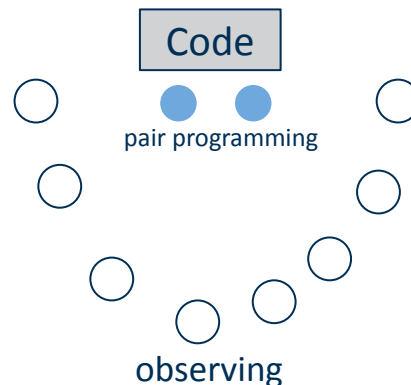
Coding Dojo 道場
